- FYI we did purchase on the “off season”, 2 space heaters that went to Katy Trail and multiple fire/smoke alarms that have since been installed or donated to fire dept for those in need
- CPW week June 21-28th, 2025 (actual work week is: 23rd-27th)
 - Camp will be at Tipton Elementary
 - Sign up sheet for Cookies for Camp
 - I will be checking with Donna at Food For Morgan County Food Pantry to see if we can utilize their kitchen again. Anyone can join us in baking cookies if they would like to (date to be determined ; shooting for Tuesday June 17th or Wednesday, June 18th to get their kitchen and starting around 3pm.)

- ***NEW*** ; 3MT crews will be rotating this year so that 1 crew isn't stuck doing the school the entire week. ; Dani to double check with Sue if we will just be missing a crew that day, or if they will actually be rotating and we will get a different crew altogether for that day.
- ***NEW*** We will be limiting the number of power washing jobs that we will be doing ; ***Bonus-Dusti has a power washer and is willing to help power wash! ; Dani, LeRoy, & Tony are also helping. THANK YOU Dusti, LeRoy, & Tony!!!
- ***SORTA NEW*** ; we can do inside organizing (house or garage), NO inside painting
- I am going to try harder to do better about the tool coverage at the job sites; do better about juggling painting and yard work not to be all on the same day for location; As of Feb 7th; We now have 30 brand new 2” angled paint brushes!!! Only 79 cents a piece
- If the homeowner wants something done that is NOT on our service agreement, and it involves \$\$, this MUST be cleared by Dani, Amy, or Jacquie before letting the homeowner know yes or no. NO exceptions! ; If

it is just another little to do job, the site leader will be responsible for making that decision (AS long as what is currently on list gets completed in the allotted time scheduled, Site leader MUST let Dani know what else was added) If site leader thinks it will take longer than allotted time scheduled, they need to let homeowner know that it will ONLY be possible IF other crews finish early and can come help, Site leader MUST get approval from Dani, Amy or Jacquie first. NO exceptions!)

- o Site Leaders are NOT to release crews early for the day! Whether they are done at their location or not. NO exceptions. There will be Fill Work to be done.

- We received a large donation of lumber and items for “rummage sale” on Jan 25, 2025
